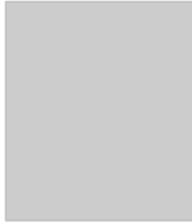

## VIVARISTIC EXPERIENCE

Allotoca goslinei, collected by Ivan Dibble. Population held at Blue Planet Aquarium. Multiple generations through to F5. 30 individuals donated to ZSL in 2007

Ameca splendens, 200 collected at Rio teuchitlan springs by R.R. Miller in 1966. Breeding continues and we have a healthy population with no abnormalities seen. This group has tested positive for mycobacterium, but this does not effect the overall clinical health of the population.

Characodon audax, 50 collected at El Toboso in 1994, brought over by Derek Lamert on 27th feb 1997. Founder stock at Chester 3.3.7. populations fluctuated. In 2015 entire group at CZ was euthanased due to inherent deformations, mostly effecting the jaw. This group also tested positive for mycobacterium.

Zoogoneticus tequilla, 80 collected at Rio Ameca basin in 1990 by dr m leonard Smith, derek lambert, L. Butler and C. Rodrigues. Additional stock recieved from Bolton Museum on the 20th may 1995 2.2.0. Population is still breeing and is clinically well, though the group is confirmed as having mycobacterium.
